Crazy Good Interviewing! Designing an Insane Selection Interview for Residencies

Residency program coordinators and administrators play a key role in the resident selection process each year. Dr. John B. Molidor will provide some effective strategies that can be put to work in the recruitment and interviewing process. This teleconference will challenge program staff to look at what went well during this past year and what can be improved upon or implemented for next year's residency interviewing cycle.
